About Como

Como offers a safe and friendly environment and everyone is made to feel welcome. Como is a beautiful town situated in a small valley surrounded by the Valtellina mountains and the point tip of the famous Lake Como. Just north of Milan and a few minutes from the Swiss border, the area is one of the most picturesque settings in Europe and the local Comaschi residents are some of the most friendly you will meet. It is an ancient, but lively town of about 85,000 and is the gateway to Lake Como. Depending on your desires, Como can be an oasis of tranquillity, natural grandeur, classical villas, a time for rest and relaxation or, for those with energy to burn, there is adventure, serious shopping, dancing and tons of fun and entertainment awaiting.

With a long history - the town was made part of the Roman empire in AD 172 - the centre has examples of pretty much anything from its past: Medieval walls, towers and streets; Renaissance Palazzi; a cathedral that took nearly four hundred years to complete; plenty of 18th century architecture and a particularly elegant early 19th century theatre.

If you are after the designer labels like Gucci, Dior, Armani, D&G at discounts of up to 70% then you are going to love nearby Foxtown!

Wining and dining or just relaxing

If eating, drinking and being merry is more your style we can arrange cooking classes, wine tastings, grappa tastings, cheese tastings or even olive oil tastings all from the local producers along the lake and surrounding Como. Museums and monuments

The Volta Temple is a museum dedicated to the inventor of the electric battery, Alessandro Volta, Museo Didattico della Seta (Silk Museum) documents the history of the silk industry in Como. The Duomo, built between XIV and XVIII centuries, is in mixed Renaissance and Gothic styles. Teatro Sociale, Villa Olmo, built from 1797 in neoclassicist style, hosted Napoleon Bonaparte & Giuseppe Garibaldi and other eminent figures and Villa Melzi (1808-1810) where tradition says Franz Liszt composed some of his most famous piano sonatas, enjoys a magnificient panorama over the lake. Villa Carlotta (picture) has an English-style park; And that's just the beainnina!



Sample Activity Week

Monday

We're taking the Funicolare to Brunate for a fantastic view of the Italian Alps and on a gorgeous sunny day you can even see the Duomo in Milano!

Tuesday

Take a walking tour of the center of Como with a local guide who escort you amongst the museums and monuments, including the Duomo di Como, built in 1396 in the Gothic style. Its artwork is in the Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque styles. Its one of the most beautiful in Italy!

Wednesday

An afternoon of art and culture. Explore the Villa Olmo and one of its International exhibitions like Klimt, Renoir, Cezanne or Picasso.

Thursday

Aperitivo is very popular in Como and is a great way to unwind at the end of the week, so the inlingua Como crew love to get together and celebrate the approaching weekend! We have also been known to roll onto a disco to dance, sing and laugh the night away. Or if you are feeling lucky you might like to take a trip to nearby Casino di Campione, one of Europe's largest casinos.

The inlingua Method

The inlingua method of teaching languages is the result of decades of practical experience. We know for certain that the method works, because we can look back on years of its successful implementation. The inlingua organization produces its own language resources, specially designed to complement the inlingua method. It is this combination of special inlingua books and special teaching techniques which entitles us to speak of "the inlingua method" as an effective and fast way to learn to speak languages. The primary aim of the inlingua method is to enable the learner to communicate as competently as possible in the foreign language. By "communicate" we mean the ability to speak and understand the target language. Of course, the inlingua method also helps the learner to read and write. The main emphasis, however, is on the spoken word. It is only by speaking the language that the learner will acquire oral competence.

The Teaching Principles

- 1. The teacher conducts the lesson in the target language only. The student should start thinking in the target language as soon as possible. Translation confuses and wastes time.
- 2. The teacher gives the learner the opportunity to speak as much as possible during the lesson. The only way in which the student will learn to speak a language is by speaking it, just as one learns to play golf by hitting a golf ball with a golf club.
- 3. The teacher conducts the greater part of the lesson orally, with the book closed. It is a fact that a language is learned by using and hearing it, therefore, the student should be less reliant on his eyes during the lessons.
- 4. The teacher concentrates more on teaching structures (i.e. how words are put together) than on teaching individual words.
- 5. The teacher controls his/her teaching in such a way that most of the sentences produced by the learner are correct.
- 6. The teacher diagnoses the extent of the learner's knowledge before supplying a model or providing a solution. The teacher should build on the student's knowledge and fill in gaps as soon as possible.
- 7. The teacher keeps theoretical explanations to a minimum.
- 8. The teacher encourages the learner to play a creative role in the learning process. In order for the student to be constructive and creative in his use of the target language, he must experiment.
- 9. The teacher observes the principles of applied psychology. The goal of the inlingua method is to make language learning as efficient and pleasant as possible. The method is flexible to give the teacher the possibility to adapt his approach to the individual requirements of the student.
- 10. The teacher combines the structural and functional approaches to language teaching. A structural approach to language learning is one which places the main emphasis on learning the structures or grammatical items of a language. The functional approach emphasizes learning how to express oneself in situations which occur in everyday life. The most efficient teaching method is the combination of both approaches. The inlingua method teaches structure on the basis of functional situations.
